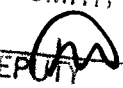

APPLICATION FOR DETERMINATION OF COMPETENCY

COMES NOW Paul Northcutt for the above-named Defendant and makes this timely Application for a Determination of the Defendant's Competency under 22 O.S. §1175.3(D)(1)(b), et seq. Pursuant, counsel would show:

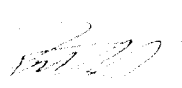
1. Attorney believes that the Defendant does not have the present ability to understand the nature of the charges and proceedings brought against the Defendant nor does the Defendant have the ability to effectively and rationally assist counsel in his defense.
2. That the attorney for Defendant believes that a qualified professional, as designated by the Oklahoma Department of Human Services, Developmental Disability Services, shall conduct a forensic competency evaluation of Defendant to determine:
3. If the person is able to appreciate the nature of the charges made against such person;
4. If the person is able to consult with their lawyer and rationally assist in the preparation of the defense of such person;
5. If the person is unable to appreciate the nature of the charges or to consult and rationally assist in the preparation of the defense, whether the person can attain competency within a reasonable time as defined in 22 O.S. § 1175.1 of this title if provided with a course of treatment, therapy, or training;
6. If the person requiring treatment as defined by 43A O.S. § 1-103;
7. If the person is incompetent because the person is intellectually disabled as defined in 10 O.S. § 1408;
8. If the answers to questions 4 and 5 are no, why the defendant is incompetent; and
9. If the person were released, whether such person would presently be dangerous as

defined in 22 O.S. § 1175.1.

10. Defendant perhaps cannot, communicate on any meaningful level with defense counsel.
11. The State of Oklahoma does not object to the Application for Determination Competency.

WHEREFORE, I respectfully request that this Court set a hearing to examine this Application and to determine whether there are facts sufficient to raise a doubt as to the competency of the Defendant; further, I request that the underlying criminal proceedings be postponed pending the determination of the Defendant's competency.

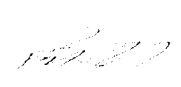
